ONE SUN, INC. TO INSTALL 750 kW SOLAR PV SYSTEM FOR THE SONOMA COUNTY, CA JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER

The system will provide approximately 40% of the campus' electricity needs and save the County of Sonoma up to \$3 million in utility costs over 25 years. The project is financed in part by funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.
